MIAMI, FL, June 3, 2011 – The Greater Miami Chamber of Commerce announced the winners of the 2011 South Florida Good To Great Awards® during its annual Goals Conference at the Hilton Miami Downtown on June 3. The regional award program honored companies based in South Florida that embody ideals from Jim Collins’ best selling business book, “Good to Great.” While the context of the award is based on the Jim Collins book, the award criteria have been localized to reflect the uniqueness of South Florida.

Four area universities, business schools at Barry University, Florida International University, Johnson & Wales University and Nova Southeastern University determined the judging criteria and shepherded the award process.
